


July Highlights

Session approved:

- The May 19, 2024, meeting minutes.
- The membership total as of 07/07/24 has not changed since our last meeting. Our total roll remains at 86.
- Received the YTD Financial report prepared by Carolyn McMillan:
 - Total YTD income for 2024 is down from past years and the total YTD expenses for 2024 are higher due to significant repairs to the building. A minute for mission regarding finances is planned to keep the congregation informed as we approach the Stewardship season.
- In Roland's absence, the recommendation to update the check authorization policy will be submitted to session in September.
- The date of September 15, 2024, for the next Session meeting. Kim Sellers volunteered to provide lunch.

- Joe thanked Session and the congregation for the consideration allowing him to take time to move.
- He also thanked Session for approving his vacation time to be with family this month. Paul shall join them at the beach.

- The request to create a doorway between the bride's room and the chapel to allow better use of these two rooms for the children attending Sunday school was approved. Art and Mitch will oversee this project.
- A section of our property that runs along Broad Street will be purchased to allow the traffic pattern on Broad Street to be improved. The church has not yet received an official proposal.
